In the north live trade ranged from \$138.00-\$142.00, mainly \$138.00-\$140.00 while dressed deals were from \$219.00-\$225.00, majority at \$221.00 dressed which is steady to slightly easier than last week's sales. Today light trade in the south continues at fully steady prices of \$138.00 live while the north is quiet. Asking prices on the remaining cattle are reported at \$140.00 plus live in the south and \$223.00 plus dressed in the north.
