U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw a light test yesterday in parts of the north at \$139.00-\$142.00 live, steady to a touch higher than last weeks trade but not enough to establish a market. Today, a light trade has surfaced in the south at \$139.00 live up \$1.00 cwt from last week's southern sales. In the north a few live deals at \$142.00 are noted which is up \$2.00-\$3.00 from last week but volumes are light. Bids in the north are reported at \$223.00 dressed but sellers are passing them. Asking prices are sitting at \$140.00 plus live in the south and \$224.00 plus dressed in the north.
