**Alberta direct trade** was moderate with prices up \$4.00-\$6.00 cwt at \$290.00 delivered on a dressed basis. Canfax notes: "Competition on the cash market remains decent with both major packers buying cattle this week. Fed cattle prices are on track to set new annual highs. Feed grain prices are at record high levels, with high cost of gains and no incentive to add additional weight to their cattle, there is motivation to get cattle marketed."
