U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week saw trade at mostly \$138.00 live in the south, with a full trading range from \$136.00-\$138.00. In the north trade was mainly \$225.00-\$226.00 dressed with a full trading range of \$223.00-\$228.00 with some live trade from \$140.00-\$147.00, most at \$142.00. Overall average prices for last week saw steers at \$140.25 live down \$2.19 cwt while heifers averaged \$240.57 down \$0.92. On the rail steers averaged \$225.80 down \$3.02 from the previous week with heifers averaging \$225.55 down \$3.85.

Monday a couple of deals in Kansas were noted at \$138.00 live, fully steady to last week's southern trade, with a few sales in lowa at \$142.00 live, steady to last week's northern deals. Agcenter.com reports "yesterday futures prices rallied off recent lows and signs turned positive for this week. Box prices were higher. Carcass weights were down. Slaughter numbers were at the highest point of the year. This set the stage for \$138 bids in Kansas where a few cattle traded at that price. This week will be an important test of market direction that has been influenced by economic fears and inflationary pressures." Today, a couple of deals in the south have surfaced at \$137.00 live, down \$1.00 from last week but volumes are too light to establish a market. Bids in the north are reported at \$138.00 live and \$225.00 dressed but sellers are not showing any interest. This week's offering is larger in volume than last week, but packers already have a lot of cattle purchased ahead which could affect this week's ability to push prices higher. Asking prices in the south are sitting at \$140.00 live while the north is unestablished at this time.
