Alberta direct trade was reported by Canfax as active on Wednesday with most sales priced around \$288.00 delivered on a dressed basis, steady to \$2.00 cwt lower than last week. U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The US cash cattle trade saw light to moderate trade develop on Wednesday, with the majority of live trade priced around \$135.00, roughly \$2.00 lower than the previous week's weighted averages. Dressed deals were priced from \$222.00-\$222.50, about \$2.00 lower than the weighted average basis Nebraska for last week. Today, a few deals were reported in the north with dressed cattle priced at \$222.00 in Nebraska, and live cattle marked at \$141.50 in lowa. Otherwise, the market was quiet and it appears that the bulk of trade has been completed for the week. A few clean up deals could continue with asking prices on the remaining cattle at \$137.00 live in the south, and \$225.00 dressed in the north.
