# U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

**The U.S. cash cattle trade** last week was mixed with steady to lower trade in the south while the north was stronger. Trade in the south was mainly \$137.00-\$138.00 live, steady to \$1.00-\$2.00 easier than the previous week while live trade in the north ranged from \$146.00-\$152.00, steady to a touch stronger. The largest increase this week was the dressed trade in the north ranging from \$230.00-\$240.00 cwt. The north, with tighter supplies, is at an \$8.00 premium to the south which has resulted in some southern cattle heading to northern packers. Overall average prices this week saw steers at \$144.55 live up \$0.88 from the previous week while live heifers averaged \$141.88 down \$0.66. Dressed deals averaged \$235.22 up \$5.49 on average while dressed heifers were up \$7.20 from the previous week at \$237.17.

Today the market was a typical Monday with show list distribution the business of the day. Bids and asking prices remain unestablished with little business expected before Wednesday. This week's offering is noting larger volumes in the north while the south has a lighter offering than last week.
