# U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week was moderate with prices slightly easier. In the south trade ranged from \$135.00-\$140.00 live, mainly \$137.00. In the north live trade ranged from \$145.00-\$151.00 while dressed deals in the north sold from \$230.00-\$238.00, mainly \$232.00. Prices overall for the week reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report saw live steers average \$144.35 down \$1.81 while heifers averaged \$141.73 down \$2.32. On the rail, steers and heifers averaged \$232.22 with steers down \$1.74 and heifers \$1.87 easier than last week on average. Today the market was quiet as both sides took inventory and new show lists were distributed. This week's offering is reported as higher in Texas and lower volumes in all other feeding states. Bids and asking prices are currently undefined with little trade expected to develop before Wednesday.
