Alberta direct trade remains at a standstill with little business expected to surface today. Canfax notes that this week's offering is larger than last week in volume.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw a couple of deals in Nebraska Monday at \$232.00 dressed which is steady to last week's average, but not nearly enough to establish a market trend. Today the market was quiet with just a couple of bids in Nebraska at \$145.00 live, but no selling interest developed. Ag center notes that with the declining fuel prices, more southern cattle are expected to move north to packers. Asking prices are currently undefined in the north but starting out at \$139.00-\$140.00 live in the south. Active trade is not expected to develop before Wednesday.
