The U.S. cash cattle trade has been challenged by weather conditions lately. According to AgCenter.com, "Heat continues to dominate ag news and developments. The heat dome centered in the nation's mid-section is not going away. Handling cattle requires early morning movements and mid day risks stress and weight loss to the animals. Temperatures were expected to be above 100 in much of the plains and from 110-120 in parts of *Oklahoma. Water consumption increases and feed consumption falls.*" <u>https://cattlereport.agcenter.com/</u> The market was quiet again today with just some light trade reported in Texas priced at \$136.00 live, steady to \$1.00 lower than last week. Asking prices are currently undefined in the north but starting out around \$139.00 live in the south.
