
ONTARIO DIRECT TO PACKER RAILGRADE CATTLE TRADE

The Stats Canada – Cattle Statistics Report was released this week, reporting steers 1 year and older on Ontario farms at 296,800 head as of July 1, 2022. Comparing July 1st to July 1st volumes, 2022 is just slightly lower than July 1, 2021 but larger than 2019 and 2020 by 4% and 3.1% respectively. Looking at fed heifers on Ontario farms, Stats Canada reported 120,900 head on July 1, 2022. The January 1, 2022 volume of fed heifers was at 117,600 head which was the lowest on farm volume in Ontario since January 2000. The July 1, 2022 volume of fed heifers is up 2.8% from January 1, 2022, but comparing just July 1st numbers it is the lowest fed heifer volume since data collection began in 1972. The total volume of fed cattle on Ontario farms on July 1, 2022 is 417,700 head down 1.3% from July 2021 but up 1.6% from 2020 and 1.3% more than July 1, 2019.





The replacement beef heifer volume on Ontario farms on July 1, 2022 was 37,500 up 300 head from January 1, 2022. Volumes of replacement beef heifers since January 1, 2021 have been the lowest since data collection began in 1972. The beef cow volume on Ontario farms was 231,200 head on July 1, 2022 up 6.2% from January 1, 2022 and 3% above last July but the third lowest volume since 1952.



Replacement cattle volumes on Ontario farms as of July 1, 2022 total 415,700 head down 1.3% from July 1, 2021 but 1.5% above July 1, 2020 and steady to July 1, 2019.

ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains at a standstill with little business expected to develop today. Canfax notes that this week's offering is larger in volume than last week.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw a light test in Iowa Monday afternoon at \$149.00 live, steady to last week's trade in that state, otherwise the market was untested. Today, a light trade had surfaced in the south at \$142.00-\$142.50 live, mostly 142.00 which is steady to last week. The northern states are quiet today with no bids reported and asking prices still undefined. The south has priced cattle this week at \$145.00 live. Higher grain futures today put pressure on the feeder cattle futures however that pressure did not spill over into the fed cattle market.
