U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade on Tuesday saw a few sales from \$227.00-\$230.00 dressed, mainly \$230.00 with a couple of live sales at \$145.00 in the north which is slightly easier, but not enough sold to establish a market. This afternoon, a light trade in the north has surfaced from \$227.00-\$229.00 dressed, mostly \$228.00 down \$4.00-\$5.00 cwt from last week's average price, with bids at \$144.00 live down at least \$2.00 but no live trade has developed. The south remains at a standstill with no bids on the table at this time, however asking prices are reported as firm \$144.00 live in the south while the north is now at \$230.00 plus dressed.

At the Central Stockyards online auction today, there were 1,204 head on offer, in 7 lots all from the south. All lots were left unsold at reserve bids of \$141.00-\$142.00 live were not met.
