ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested but Canfax notes that packer interest should improve this afternoon. Canfax reports: "This week's showlist has been compiled with volumes larger than the previous week. With fewer grid cattle being committed to the packer has resulted in improved buying interest on the cash market. The non-fed market is starting to see some seasonal weakness. Competition on the non-fed market remains disappointing with only one major packer buying cows this week."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade remains at a standstill at time of reporting as sellers hold for higher prices and packers bid lower with just a few bids in parts of Nebraska at \$222.00 dressed with \$226.00 dressed noted in lowa which is lower than last week's \$228.00-\$229.00 averages. A couple of deals yesterday were noted at \$228.00 dressed which is steady but not nearly enough sold to establish a market. Asking prices in the south are stronger this week at \$144.00 live while the north has yet to be established, however it is expected to be higher than last week. Business is possible at some point this afternoon but before that can happen one side is going to have to give. At the Central Stockyards online auction today, there were 1,075 head on offer, in 6 lots, all from Texas with delivery in 2-11 days. All lots were bid from \$140.25-\$140.50 but no cattle traded as bids were below the \$144.00 reserve price.
