ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested with little business expected to develop today. Canfax reports that this week's offering is larger than last week in volume with asking prices around \$307.00-\$308.00 cwt delivered on a dressed basis.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw a couple of hundred head sell in Iowa on Monday at \$147.00 live which is steady to the top of last week's sales and up \$2.00-\$3.00 on average, but not nearly enough sold to establish a market trend for this week. Today a few bids in Nebraska and Iowa surfaced at \$145.00 live but no selling interest has developed at this time, while the south remains at a standstill. Bids in the south are reported from \$145.00-\$146.00 live up \$2.00-\$3.00 from last week's southern trade, while asking prices in the north remain unestablished. Active trade is not expected to develop before Wednesday at the earliest. This Friday, the Cattle On Feed Report is released and analysts are predicting lower numbers.
