**Alberta direct trade** on Wednesday was reported by Canfax as light with prices holding fully steady to last week from \$300.00-\$305.00 cwt delivered on a dressed basis. Cattle sold are being scheduled for the first two weeks of November delivery. Canfax reports: "No premiums were noted if cattle graded over 70% AAA. Sales volumes are still light, but more inquiries will be made today. Feeding conditions have been ideal this summer and daily gains have been impressive." Canfax will be closed on Friday in observation of the National Day of Truth and Reconciliation.
