Alberta direct trade was light on Wednesday notes Canfax at \$302.00 delivered on a dressed basis, up \$2.00 cwt from last week. Canfax also notes: "Light volumes of Alberta fed cattle trade traded to the US, depending on freight and dressing percentage, sales to the US are working back to the mid 180's FOB the feedlot. Sales to the US are at a premium over local deals."

The US cash cattle trade was light on Wednesday with sales in the south reported at \$147.00 live up \$2.00 cwt from last week. In the north trade was reported limited at \$150.00 live and \$234.00-\$235.00 dressed, also up \$2.00 from last week's northern trade but not enough sold to establish a market. Today a light trade in the south is up \$3.00 from last week at \$148.00 live. In the north, light scattered business is starting to surface at \$150.00-\$152.00 live up \$3.00-\$5.00 from last week with bids sitting at \$235.00-\$236.00 dressed up \$3.00-\$4.00, with just a couple of deals in Iowa at \$236.00 dressed, up \$4.00 cwt. Asking prices are holding firm at \$148.00 plus live in the south and \$237.00 plus dressed in the north.
