### **U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)**

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week was fully steady although sellers were hoping for better prices. In the south trade ranged from \$147.00-\$150.00 live, mainly \$150.00 while deals in the north ranged from \$153.0-\$156.00 live, mainly \$153.00 with dressed trade from \$237.00-\$244.00, mainly \$242.00. Overall average prices for the week, reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report saw live steers average \$152.71 up \$0.73 while heifers averaged \$152.30 up \$0.15. On the rail, steers averaged \$241.34 down \$0.56 with heifers averaging \$242.09 up \$0.48.

Today the market was quiet with no bids on the table. Asking prices remain unestablished and could stay that way until Tuesday or later. This week's offering is reported as lower in Texas in volume, with all other feeding states reporting more cattle than last week. Packers are buying for a short week as the American Thanksgiving is next week.
