Today, a couple of bids in Nebraska were noted at \$238.00 dressed but sellers showed no interest in the lower bids. Asking prices in the south are sitting at \$151.00-\$152.00 live however the north remains unestablished. Active trade is not expected to develop before Wednesday at the earliest.
