Alberta direct trade remains untested with little business expected to develop today. Canfax reports that this week's offering is steady to last week in volume.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade is quiet today with just a few bids noted in Nebraska at \$242.00-\$245.00 dressed, steady to \$1.00 higher than last week but no selling interest has developed. The south is very quiet so far. This week's offering is reported as smaller in the south but larger in the north in volume, with asking prices in the south from \$154.00-\$155.00 live while the north remains unestablished. If packers want to get business wrapped up before the holiday on Thursday they are going to have to be more aggressive with their bids on Wednesday.
