#### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

**Alberta direct trade** remains at a standstill with little business expected to develop today. Canfax notes that this week's offering is steady to last week in volume, with asking prices steady to last week at \$310.00 cwt delivered on a dressed basis. Canfax reports: "Over the past four weeks western Canadian fed slaughter has averaged 42,000 head/week compared to 44,000 head/week last year. From their highs in late October steer carcass weights have declined 30lbs."

## U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw a couple of deals on Monday afternoon in Nebraska at \$248.00 dressed which is fully steady to last week but not enough sold to establish a market. Today the market was very quiet with no bids on the table and little business expected to develop before Wednesday at the earliest. Asking prices in the south are starting to surface at \$157.00 plus live while the north remains undefined. Cattle futures were sharply lower today, unable to find support as boxed beef prices continue to decline.
