

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle market last week was light in the south with sales from \$153.00-\$155.50 live, mainly \$155.00 which is just steady. In the north live trade ranged from \$155.00-\$159.00, mostly \$156.00 which is also steady. Dressed trade ranged from \$245.00-\$248.00 with majority at \$248.00 up \$1.00 cwt. Overall average prices for the week reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report saw live steers average \$155.69 down \$0.10 from the previous week while heifers averaged \$155.64 live up \$0.09. On the rail steers averaged \$247.80 up \$0.98 with heifers averaging \$247.58 up \$0.79.

Today, the market was quiet as both sides took inventory and new show lists were distributed. This week's offering is larger in Kansas and smaller in volume in all other feeding states. No bids were on the table today and asking prices are undefined. Little business is expected to develop before Wednesday.
