### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested however some business is expected to develop later today. Canfax reports: "Getting closer to the holidays many producers have marketed what they need to as this week's cash offering is light. With extremely cold temperatures across the prairies cattle performance has been impacted. Packers are likely running reduced hours, there have been a couple reports cattle that were scheduled to be shipped out this week were cancelled due to the weather."

### U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

**The U.S. cash cattle trade** remains at a standstill with no new trade reported. A few bids in the south are noted at \$153.00 live but sellers are not showing any interest. Asking prices in the south are sitting at \$156.00-\$157.00 plus live while the north is still undefined. Some business could still develop this afternoon ahead of the winter storm and extreme cold expected to hit most feeding states tonight and tomorrow. Agcenter.com reports: "The winter solstice is bringing along the coldest temperatures of the winter and possibly several winters and in some cases threatening the welfare of livestock across the plains. Potential record-breaking frigid temperatures may delay marketing plans of cattle owners unless higher prices are offered this week. "

At the Central Stockyards online auction today, there were 992 head on offer, in 7 lots with delivery in 1-10 days. All lots were left unsold as bids from \$153.00-\$153.75 were below the reserve bids set at \$156.00-\$157.00 live.
