ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade was light on Wednesday with prices \$2.00 cwt stronger than last week from \$306.00-\$307.00 delivered on a dressed basis. Canfax reports: "Competition on the cash market remains limited with one packer buying most of the cattle. US packer interest has been quiet so far this week. Not only have cash volumes been light but packers are also getting fewer grid cattle committed to them. With bitterly cold temperatures many producers are primarily focused on keeping cattle bedded and thawing waters. Selling inquires have been light and sale volumes are excepted to be very light."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The US cash cattle trade saw a couple of deals in lowa yesterday from \$246.00-\$248.00 dressed, steady to \$1.00 lower than last week but not enough to establish a market. Bids in the south were noted at \$153.00 live but sellers were not interested. At time of reporting A light trade is developing in parts of the North at \$249.00 dressed up \$1.00 cwt from last week's average prices, while the south remains at a standstill. Asking prices are reported from \$156.00-\$157.00 live in the south and \$249.00 plus dressed in the north. The frigid temperatures and loads of snow now have feedlots more concerned with animal welfare and digging out, rather than marketing. Packer interest is expected to improve as the day progressed but it is likely going to take higher bids to spark decent selling interest.
