Alberta direct trade saw a light trade develop on Wednesday at \$312.00-\$312.50 cwt delivered on a dressed basis notes Canfax, up \$2.00-\$2.50 from last week's sales. Canfax reports: "Competition on the cash market remains decent with both major packers buying cattle. US packer interest has been quiet so far this week. A lot of the cattle being marketed right now have break-evens on either side of \$200.00/cwt (live basis). Fed prices are currently in the mid \$180.00's/cwt (live basis) suggesting feedlot losses are around \$225.00/head."

The US cash cattle trade just saw a handful of deals on Wednesday in Iowa and a couple in Nebraska at \$251.00-\$252.00 dressed, steady but not nearly enough sold to establish a market. Today, bids in the south were reported from \$154.00-\$155.00 live down \$2.00-\$3.00 from last week's trade while in the north bids ranged from \$156.00-\$157.00 live and \$250.00-\$252.00 dressed, steady to \$2.00 easier but the bids did not attract any selling interest. Asking prices are holding firm at \$158.00-\$159.00 live in the south and \$253.00 plus dressed in the north. Active trade could be delayed until Friday.
