ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade was light on Wednesday with Canfax reporting trade at \$338.00 cwt delivered on a dressed basis, up \$3.00-\$6.00 cwt from last week's trade with delivery the second half of March. Canfax reports: "Competition on the cash market remains limited with one packer buying most of the cattle. This week most of the cash sales were reported flat with no heavy weight carcass discounts. Fed cattle prices are currently averaging over 200.00/cwt, a new annual high. Not only have fed prices increased but butcher cow prices have as well. Top end cows are now trading in the low to mid \$120/cwt through auction facilities."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The US cash cattle trade saw a light test in parts of the north yesterday from \$161.00-\$166.00 live, mainly \$164.00-\$165.00, steady to \$1.00 cwt higher with a few deals on a dressed basis from \$262.00-\$265.00 dressed, but not enough to establish a market. Today, the market is seeing a few bids in the north at \$262.00 dressed, but sellers are resisting. The south remains at a complete standstill with no bids on the table and no trade reported so far this week. Asking prices in the south are sitting around \$166.00 plus live while the north is still undefined. It looks like another week of Friday trading as sellers hold out for higher prices again this week.
