U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The US cash cattle trade was light to moderate on Wednesday with business in the south starting out earlier in the day at prices from \$162.00-\$163.00 live, mainly \$163.00 cwt down \$1.00 on average. In the north live trade developed in the afternoon with sales reported from \$164.00-\$166.00 live, mainly \$165.00 with a few choice cattle at \$168.00 while on the rail, prices ranged from \$264.00-\$268.00 dressed, mainly \$265.00 up \$1.00. Today, a few bids are noted at \$264.00-\$265.00 dressed in the north but no sales are reported at this time. Asking prices are reported at \$165.00 live in the south and \$265.00 plus dressed in the north but it appears that the bulk of trade is completed. Agcenter.com notes: "Cattle from grasslands in the southern plains move into Texas and Kansas feedyards in October while lighter calf crops are placed on feed in the north later in the fall. This placement pattern provides larger supplies of fed cattle in the southern planes during the March/April period reversing course with more fed supplies in the north during the May/June time frame. This supply situation is contributing to the widening of the prices between the northern and southern plains."
