ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade was light on Wednesday with prices \$2.00-\$5.00 cwt stronger than last week from \$397.00-\$400.00 cwt delivered on a dressed basis. Canfax reports: "One major packer is looking for quick delivery cattle while the other is buying cattle roughly 3 weeks out. Over the past couple of weeks grid volumes have been very light, this is not overly surprising as the grid base price is at a discount to the cash market. As a general rule of thumb on a rising market, (like what we are dealing with now) the grid price is usually a couple weeks behind."

The U.S. cash cattle trade was light to moderate on Wednesday. Business in the south ranged from \$168.00-\$174.00 live, mainly \$171.00 which is steady to \$1.00 higher. In the north live trade ranged from \$180.00-\$185.00, mostly \$180.00-\$183.00 up \$2.00-\$5.00 cwt with dressed deals ranging from \$280.00-\$287.00 cwt, mostly \$285.00-\$286.00 up \$4.00-\$5.00 cwt. Today the market is quiet and it appears the bulk of trade is completed ahead of the long weekend in the U.S. Some clean up trade could still surface with asking prices on the few remaining cattle at \$173.00 live in the south and \$288.00 plus dressed in the north.
