#### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains at a standstill with limited packer interest noted to date. Asking prices are reported at around \$417.00 cwt delivered on a dressed basis but no trade has surfaced at this time.

## U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade was light on Tuesday afternoon in the south with sales in Kansas at \$178.00 live in and \$178.00-\$179.00 in Texas, down \$1.00-\$2.00 from last week's southern trade. The north was untested. Today, sellers are resisting the lower bids of \$178.00-\$179.00 live in the south and \$179.00-\$181.00 dressed in the north and holding out for asking prices that are sitting at \$182.00 live in the south and \$290.00 plus dressed in the north. It appears that active trade is going to be delayed until Thursday or Friday, especially in the north.

At the Central Stockyards online auction today there were 1,326 head on offer, in 8 lots with delivery in 5-13 days, all from Texas. Two lots sold at \$180.75, one lot was scratched and the remaining 5 lots were unsold as reserve bids from \$179.00-\$180.00 live were not met.
