## U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week was light in volume. In the south trade ranged from $\$ 178.00-\$ 184.00$ live, mainly $\$ 178.00-\$ 179.00$ down $\$ 1.00-\$ 2.00$ from the previous week. In the north dressed deals ranged from $\$ 280.00-\$ 290.00$ cwt, mainly $\$ 288.00-\$ 290.00$ which is steady to $\$ 2.00$ lower while live sales ranged from $\$ 182.00-\$ 184.00$ which is $\$ 1.00$ easier to $\$ 1.00$ higher than the week before. Prices overall for the week, reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report, saw live steers averaging $\$ 181.33$ cwt down $\$ 1.24$ from the previous week while heifers averaged $\$ 180.65$ down $\$ 1.45$. On the rail steers averaged $\$ 289.37$ dressed, down $\$ 0.47$ while heifers averaged $\$ 289.76$ up $\$ 1.21$ cwt from the previous week's weighted average prices.
Monday saw no new trade reported and very little happened ahead of today's Independence Day Holiday. The U.S. is closed today in observation of that holiday. Business will pick up on Wednesday but sellers will be looking for higher prices as supplies remain tight. Packer purchases the previous week were light but this week is a short week due to the holiday. Next week is a full week and packers should be a little more aggressive to fill their processing needs.
