

## U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

**The U.S. cash cattle trade** last week took place between Tuesday to Friday, with slightly easier prices. Trade in the south was from \$177.00-\$179.00 live, mainly \$179.00 down \$1.00 from the previous week. In the north trade ranged from \$290.00-\$298.00 dressed, most from \$293.00-\$295.00 which is steady to \$2.00 lower with live sales from \$186.00-\$188.00, steady to \$2.00 lower. Overall prices for the week, reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report, saw live steers average \$185.04 down \$0.84 cwt from the previous week while live heifers averaged \$184.79 up \$0.53. On the rail steers averaged \$293.76 down \$1.84 with heifers averaging \$294.54 down \$0.69.

Today the market was quiet as both sides took inventory and new show lists were distributed. Bids and asking prices are currently undefined and could remain that way until mid-week however asking prices are expected to be higher. This week's offering is reported as smaller in volume, especially in the south. Friday's Cattle On Feed Report shows on feed numbers down 2% over last year with placements down 8%. Marketing's were also down 5% over last year. Agcenter.com reports: "The monthly COF report combined with improvements in beef demand last week will provide a better tone to this week's market. Temperature while still hot for late August are showing signs of moderating and the upcoming Labor Day holiday will spur beef demand that seasonally improves this time of year. Cattle owners will seek to improve selling prices while packers will want to crush losses at the beef plant into the black following several weeks of red ink."
