



Stats Canada released the July 1, 2023 Cattle Inventory Report today. In Ontario, the volume of fed cattle on Ontario farms totaled 439,200 head on July 1, 2023 which is up 5% from July 2022 and up 11.2% over January 2023, but typically July volumes are higher than January 1st inventories. The July 1st inventory of fed steers and heifers is the largest volume since July 2018. In the mix July 1, 2023 steers are up 19% from January 1, 2023 and up just 5.5% over the previous July 1st numbers and is the largest July inventory since 2018. Heifer volumes on July 1, 2023 are also up slightly over January by 4.5% and 3.8% higher than July 2022. Heifer volumes on July 1, 2023 are the largest since July 2020.






The Stats Canada inventory of beef cows on Ontario farms on July 1, 2023 was 227,800 head, up 0.7% from January but 4.5% below July 2022 and is the second lowest July 1 beef cow inventory since 1953.

The Stats Canada inventory of beef replacement heifers on Ontario farms on July 1, 2023 was 36,600 up 6.7% from January this year but 3.7% below July 1, 2022 inventories. The July 1, 2023 number is the second lowest volume (fully steady to July 1, 2021) reported in this data set and even further back than 2009.



The Stats Canada cattle inventory of calves under 1 year on Ontario farms on July 1, 2023 was 421,700 head, down 2% from January 1, 2023 and down 1% from July 1, 2022. Volumes are generally lower in July than in January however this year the decline was lighter than usual. The July 1, 2023 inventory is fully steady to July 1, 2016 with only July 1, 2022 larger in volume since that time.

ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Tuesday remained untested however some business could start to surface this afternoon. Canfax reports: "From a supply standpoint, seasonally fed cattle supplies remain ample. and packers have gained leverage over the cattle feeder. Despite lower prices and weaker basis levels it can not be ignored fed cattle prices still remain historically strong. Slaughter rates have been much lighter than normal this summer and this has backed supplies up a little bit. Over the past month and a half, the Canadian dollar has declined 3% this should be supportive to the fed market and encourage beef exports."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade remains untested as sellers pass the bids in the north at \$290.00 dressed, while the south is quiet. Sellers are pricing cattle higher this week on a lighter offering despite the pressure on cattle futures Tuesday. Boxed beef prices continue to show some strength but packers are wanting cattle at steady to lower prices as margins are reported as poor. Packers are keeping chain speed lower also in order to boost margins. Packers have cattle bought out which could also keep them less aggressive on the cash market this week however on the other side of the coin, numbers of ready cattle remain tight.

At the Central Stockyards online auction today there were 1,430 head on offer, in 8 lots with delivery in 1-13 days. One lot was scratched, one lot from Texas sold at \$179.75 live, up slightly from last week's trade while the remaining lots were left unsold as reserve bids of \$180.00-\$182.00 live were not met.
