Alberta direct trade is untested so far this week however some light trade could start to surface this afternoon. Canfax reports: "There have been rumblings one plant has been making inquires looking for cattle."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade has been very limited so far this week with just a couple of lots on Monday trading in lowa at \$290.00 dressed and a couple on Tuesday were noted from \$180.00-\$184.00 live in Nebraska but not nearly enough cattle have changed hands to establish a market trend. Today, the market remains very quiet with no bids on the table. Asking prices in the south are starting to surface at \$183.00 live however the north is still unestablished. Active trade is note expected to develop before Thursday at the earliest.

At the Central Stockyards online auction today there were 1418 head on offer, in 10 lots with delivery in 1-17 days. All cattle were left unsold as reserve bids of \$183.00-\$186.00 live were not met.
