ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested with little business expected today. Canfax notes that this week's offering is steady to last week in volume. Canfax reports: "For the week ending September 16th Western Canadian fed processing totaled over 46,000 head, 6% larger than the same week last year. This is not only the largest processed volume of the year but is the first-time processed volumes have been above last year since the end of June. In addition to larger processing rates, there has also been an uptick in Canadian fed cattle being shipped into the US."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade has been very quiet with just a couple of deals in the north noted yesterday at \$293.00 dressed which is steady to \$1.00 higher but not nearly enough to establish any kind of market, only 2 lots sold. Today the market was very quiet with no bids on the table. Asking prices started to surface in parts of Texas at \$186.00 live but most areas are unestablished and may stay that way until Thursday following sharply lower cattle futures today. Today's sell off was mainly a result of pressure on the outside markets. Economic uncertainty grows and worries that interest rates will stay higher for longer than originally estimated could result in hard times for consumers.
