ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested however some scattered deals could start to surface this afternoon. Canfax reports: There have been rumblings steady money was being bid yesterday. Packers will likely be pulling hard on October contract cattle. With ample fed cattle numbers and lots of cows around as well packers are well positioned with cattle. The Canadian dollar continues to move lower, this is positive news for the cattle market and should encourage Canadian beef exports"

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade was light to moderate on Tuesday in the south with sales from \$181.00-\$182.00, majority at \$182.00 cwt live which is \$1.00 cwt easier than last week's southern average prices. A light test in parts of the north Tuesday saw live sales from \$183.00-\$184.00, most at \$183.00 live which is also \$1.00 below last week's northern average prices. Today, bids in the north are sitting at \$182.00-\$183.00 live and \$288.00-\$290.00 dressed which is steady to slightly easier than last week but no sales have developed at this time. Bids in the south are steady to Tuesday at \$182.00 live. Asking prices are reported at \$183.00 plus live in the south and \$290.00 plus dressed in the north.

At the Central Stockyards online auction today there were 1,478 head on offer, in 12 lots. Three lots sold from \$182.50-\$183.00 live, one lot of Holsteins sold at \$175.50 live. The remaining cattle did not sell as reserve bids from \$182.50-\$184.00 live were not met. Cattle with delivery dates differed to November had reserve bids of \$189.00 but no trade occurred.
