ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains at a standstill with little business expected to develop today. Canfax reports that this week's offering is smaller than the week before and one of the smallest this year. Asking prices are being reported from \$394.00-\$395.00 cwt delivered on a dressed basis but no bids have surfaced at this time.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade remains untested with the exception of 36 head trading in Iowa at \$185.00 live, but not enough to establish a market by any means. No bids have surfaced so far with little trade expected before the second half of the week. Asking prices are currently unestablished but there are expected to be higher than last week's trade.
