#### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade saw a light trade surface Wednesday at \$390.00 delivered on a dressed basis which is fully steady to last week. Canfax notes: "Live sales were reported at 232.00 FOB lot, 1.00 lower than last week's weighted average price. Competition on the cash market remains decent with all three Western Canadian packers buying cattle. US packers are looking at formula pricing fed cattle. Western Canadian fed cattle that are being committed to the US packer will likely be priced off the five-area average."

The U.S. cash cattle trade so far has been fairly quiet this week with the exception of a few scattered deals in parts of the north early week from \$186.00-\$187.00 live and \$291.00-\$295.00 dressed, mainly \$292.00, but not nearly enough sold to establish a market. Bids of \$182.00-\$183.00 live in the south were passed on Wednesday as sellers held for higher prices. Today a light trade has surfaced in Nebraska at \$186.00 live and \$294.00 dressed, up \$2.00 from last week but trade is light. A couple of deals in Kansas have been noted at \$184.00 live, up \$1.00 from last week while bids in Texas at \$184.00 live are being passed at this time. Asking prices are reported at \$186.00 plus live in the south and \$295.00 plus dressed in the north.
