## U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week was light with most business delayed until Friday afternoon, with some cattle being carried over to this week in the south. Business in the south was very light with sales from \$181.00-\$185.00 live, majority at \$185.00 which is steady to \$2.00 stronger than the previous week's southern trade. In the north sales ranged from \$184.00-\$185.00 live, steady to slightly lower while dressed deals were reported from \$287.00-\$294.00, mainly \$292.00 cwt up around \$2.00. Overall average prices for the week, reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report, saw live steers average \$184.89 up \$0.87 cwt while heifers averaged \$184.90 up \$0.68. On the rail steers averaged \$291.92 dressed up \$1.86 cwt while heifers averaged \$291.93 up \$1.94. Today the market was quiet as new show lists were distributed. This week's offering is reported to be larger in volume in the south while the north has fewer cattle on offer. Bids and asking prices are unestablished with little trade expected to surface before midweek. Cattle futures were under pressure today, down triple digits, as analysts estimate higher numbers on feed and placed on the next Cattle on Feed Report on the 17th.
