### U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw a couple of deals in Iowa on Monday afternoon at \$181.00 live but not enough sold to establish a market. Today the country was at a standstill with no bids on the table and asking prices unestablished. Cattle futures saw another round of sharply lower prices today with feeders under extreme pressure. Fundamentally, ready cattle numbers remain tight which should support the cash market near term but we will have to wait for cash to develop. Agcenter.com reports: "The Bull and Bear camps battling for the future of cattle prices is far from over. The differing views come in waves of action on the futures board and Monday it was the Bears who spoke with a passion taking away a lot of recent gains. No one disagrees that cattle numbers will continue to shorten. The disagreement is over whether smaller numbers of cattle can command a higher price or is beef selling at the top of the range consumers will tolerate. Strong cases can be found with each side."
