Alberta direct trade on Wednesday was light with sales reported from \$360.00-\$368.00 delivered on a dressed basis, which is steady to \$3.00 cwt stronger than last week. Canfax noted that cattle sold this week are being scheduled for delivery anywhere from late January to early March, depending on the purchasing packer. Canfax reports: "Buying interest has been noted from all three Western Canadian packers. With cold temperatures some cattle that were scheduled to be shipped out this week could be canceled."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw a light test in lowa Wednesday with prices steady to last week's northern sales at \$174.00-\$175.00 live and \$275.00 dressed, while all other feeding states were at a complete standstill. The severe winter weather, power outages and transportation issues due to the weather have reduced processing volumes at some plants. Cattle weights are declining in the harsh conditions and there are reports some feedlots are pulling cattle from this week's show list and holding on for a week or two. Some areas are still dealing with the severe winter weather today and in some areas another weather event is unfolding. Asking prices are sitting around \$174.00 plus live in the south and \$276.00 plus dressed in the north. Trade will be light this week as many sellers are more concerned with taking care of their livestock and dealing with the severe weather than selling. Today a few bids in Nebraska and Iowa are sitting from \$272.00-\$275.00 dressed but no sales have surfaced at this time.
