ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains at a standstill with little trade expected today. Canfax notes that this week's offering is smaller than last week in volume. Canfax reports: "For early January Western Canadian carcass weights remain record large. Steer and heifer carcass weights are over 60lbs heavier than last year."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade final results for last week overall, saw live steers average \$173.47 down \$0.54 with heifers averaging \$173.36 down \$0.49 cwt on average. On the rail, steers averaged \$273.70 dressed, down \$1.08 cwt with heifers averaging \$273.06 down \$1.26.

This week's offering is reported as slightly smaller in volume with asking prices at around \$174.00-\$175.00 live in the south while the north is unestablished. No bids have surfaced at this time. Trade last week was light due to the severe weather and frigid temperatures in many states are being reported again this week and will likely delay trade until later in the week. Carcass weights will be lighter as a result of the harsh winter conditions. Demand appears to be improving as boxed beef prices have been slowly strengthening.
