ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Tuesday no new trade to report but there is a good chance scattered trade will develop by this afternoon. Packers are well covered with contract cattle and there has also been a slight uptick cattle being marketed on the grid. Based on light sale volumes last week Alberta fed basis levels are the weakest since early November. With negative feeding margins and weak basis levels many producers are fighting the market and adding more weight to their cattle.
