ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested with little business expected to develop today. Canfax notes that this week's offering is smaller in volume than last week. Canfax reports: "From a supply perspective, yearling numbers are seasonally declining while fed calves are probably 30-45 days away from hitting the market. With negative feedlot margins and lower feed grain prices there is little incentive to pull fed calves forward and sell them ahead of schedule."

The U.S. cash cattle trade is untested and could stay that way until mid-week. No bids have surfaced at this time with asking prices expected to be higher this week, with just a few lots in the south asking \$188.00 plus live so far. Boxed beef prices continue to improve which could support higher asking prices.

Agcenter.com reports: "Processors should benefit from a kick in spring demand for beef that will cause retailers to push inventory levels higher in anticipation of or following improved demand demonstrated at the meat counter. Processing levels moved higher last week and may be higher again this week."
