Canfax reports "Western Canadian packers are not getting a lot of grid cattle committed to them, which should support interest on the cash market."

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw a couple of deals late Monday in the north at \$190.00 live which is fully steady but only 276 head sold which is not a market maker. Monday the futures market overreacted to the news of one person contracting the bird flue which sent the futures sharply lower. Today futures bounced back slightly but did not recover yesterday's losses, which is expected to take a little time. Packers will be looking to buy cattle cheaper this week but sellers are not looking to sell at lower prices. Asking prices are unestablished with just a few lots in the south starting to price cattle at \$188.00 cwt live up \$2.00 from last week's southern trade.
