## **ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE**

Alberta direct trade remains untested with little business expected to develop today. Canfax notes that this week's offering is larger than last week in volume with higher asking prices. Canfax reports: "Last week on a cash-to-cash basis Alberta fed prices were at a \$4.00/cwt premium against the Nebraska market, the strongest basis since June of last year. Despite strong prices in Western Canada, Canadian fed cattle shipments to the US remain historically large. With tighter fed cattle supplies and big fed cattle shipments to the US. There have been rumblings Western Canadian packers could start to scale back hours. Fed cattle from Manitoba are coming west into Alberta for processing."
