U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

Last week, dressed sales in the Northern feeding states ranged from \$312.00-317.00/cwt with most trade at \$312.00/cwt, \$2.00-3.00/cwt higher. Live sales in Texas and Kansas were at \$190.00/cwt, steady to \$1.00/cwt stronger. USDA released its quarterly hog report last week. As of June 1st, US hog inventories totaled 74.5 million head, 1% larger than last year. The average pigs saved per litter was 11.56 for the March-May period, compared to 11.36 from last year. Hogs kept for breeding totaled 6.01 million head, 3% lower than last year. Reduced slaughter capacity, with one plant in lowa last shift was on June 28th, could pose a headwind for the pork industry. Based on the latest acreage report, corn acres were reported at 91.5 million acres, larger than earlier forecasts. Even though corn acres are down from last year, this is still the 8th highest acres since the mid 1940's.
