ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Tuesday saw no new trade to report. Asking prices remain at \$435.00/cwt delivered. With the Cargill plant resuming operations, the number of Eastern Canadian fed cattle coming into Alberta for processing should slow down. Western Canadian carcass weights have likely bottomed and are expected to increase until the fall.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw around 2,000 head of cattle were traded between Texas and Kansas yesterday with live sales at \$188.00/cwt, traded \$2.00/cwt lower than the previous week. In lowa live sales were ranged from \$190.00-\$194.00/cwt, \$4.00-\$8.00/cwt weaker. Today on the Fed Cattle Exchange, a few cattle in Texas were traded at \$188.00/cwt and bid the grid sales in lowa and Kansas were at \$193.00/cwt. Over the past two days, the August live cattle contract has dropped more than 400 points. Market sentiment has shifted with concerns about lighter slaughter rates, and historically large carcass weights and weaker beef demand for the second half of the year.
