### **ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE**

**Alberta direct trade** on Tuesday saw no new trade to report. Butcher cow prices are looking stronger this week, should bode well for fed cattle market. Asking prices are holding at \$435.00/cwt delivered. For the week ending July 13<sup>th</sup>, Western Canadian cow slaughter totaled just over 4,100 head, 38% than last year. For the first part of July, this is the smallest cow slaughter since 2004.

#### U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

**The U.S. cash cattle trade** yesterday saw light trade reported in Texas, Kansas, and Oklahoma with live sales from \$187.00-\$188.00/cwt, traded steady to \$1.00/cwt lower than last week. Today, asking prices of \$190.00+/cwt have been noted in the South, while in the North business remains quiet with no bids reported. According to USDA for the week ending July 21<sup>st,</sup> 67% of the US corn crop was rated in good to excellent condition compared to 57% from last year.
