U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week saw dressed sales in the Northern feeding states at \$296.00/cwt, traded \$2.00/cwt higher than the previous week. While live sales were reported at \$186.00-\$187.00/cwt, fully steady. In the South live sales were reported from \$186.00/cwt, traded \$1.00-\$2.00/cwt higher. Last week volume of cattle processed was estimated at 611,000 head, 16,000 head smaller than last year. From their lows in late August/early September feeder cattle contracts have gain \$13.00-\$18.00/cwt while live cattle contracts have rallied \$10.00-\$15.00/cwt.
