## **ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE**

Alberta direct trade saw the Canadian fed market establish new highs in Eastern and Western Canada. Fed prices have trended steady to higher for the past ten weeks, gaining \$33/cwt or around \$500/head. Last week, dressed sales were reported from \$495.00-500.00/cwt delivered. Larger cash volumes are traditionally seen in May, however, that has not necessarily been the case this year. Many producers have indicated a larger percentage of their May cattle are contracted due to uncertainty with US tariffs. Over the past couple of weeks, butcher cows have been averaging on either side of \$230/cwt, prices are \$42/cwt higher than last year.

## U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week saw dressed sales in Iowa and Nebraska ranged from \$350-360/cwt (mostly \$358/cwt), \$2/cwt higher than the previous week. Live sales in the North were at \$229/cwt, \$1-4/cwt higher while sales in Texas and Kansas were from \$218-220/cwt, fully steady. Over the past three weeks, pork production has averaged 529 million pounds, 2.5% larger than last year. For the month of May, pork production is record large. Despite the larger production, pork cutout values have advanced, trading right-inline with a year ago
