ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Monday saw no new trade to report, showlist volumes are larger than the previous week. Last week's Alberta fed cash-to-futures basis was the strongest seen this year. Based on the five-year average, fed basis levels historically peak in early June. With historically small slaughter cattle exports to the US over the past few weeks, and reduced slaughter volumes in Western Canadian could start to back supplies up. Western Canadian lift times have started to stretch out. Asking prices have been reported at \$505+/cwt delivered.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade significant trade will likely be delayed until the second half of this week. Asking prices are poorly defined but are expected to start out around \$225/cwt in the South and \$235/cwt in the North. A lot of eyes will be on the beef markets today as many try and get a gauge on how good retail and food service demand was over the holiday. Fill-in business should support the beef complex in the near term. Last Friday's cattle on feed report was viewed as neutral as placements and marketings were in line with expectations. Feedlot placements for the month of April were 3% below last year. Over the past fifteen years, this ranks as the fourth lowest April placement volume, the only years that were smaller in 2012, 2015 and 2020. Reduced imports of Mexican feeder cattle have had a significant impact on cattle on feed inventories in the South. Cattle on feed inventories between Texas and Kansas are down 190,000 head versus last year. For Texas, this is the smallest May 1st cattle on feed inventory since 2017.
