U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw no new trade to report. Today, packer interest remains light with no bids to speak of. Asking prices are not established but are anticipated to start out around \$238.00/cwt live in the North and \$226.00/cwt live in the South. Significant trade is likely to be delayed until the second half of this week. Four state showlist volumes have been reported larger. Looking at the grain markets, according to USDA 93% of the US corn crop is planted, ahead of last year and right inline with the five-year average. The December corn contract has traded lower for 7 consecutive trading days dropping 20 cents per bushel.
